

Dear Resident:

The City of Canton's Sanitation Department collects trash weekly from the city's residents and also provides service to residents outside the city each day. Collections take place Monday through Friday, during the hours of 6:00am-2:00pm with each customer receiving a weekly pick-up regardless of the weather. However, to assure the safety of our waste collectors, subzero temperatures and negative wind chill will hinder operations.

Included here are some "tips" about your sanitation service. Your cooperation with them is most appreciated.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE REMINDER:

Trash pick-up will **not** occur on the following holidays

Trash pick-up will resume the day following the above holidays, and be a day behind the normal pick-up day the rest of the week following the holidays listed above.

Do's and Don't's

DO's

- * Use Trash containers no larger than 32 gallons.
- * Trash containers must have handles and separate lids.
- * Trash containers shall be properly secured with lids at all time to prevent animal access to the container.
- * Bags may be used without containers. Bags may also be used with containers larger than 32 gallons **provided** the bags are removed from the trash containers on pick-up day. **(Note: if bags are placed out without containers and animals get into the bags it is the resident's responsibility to clean up the trash and re-bag it.)**
- * Place your trash containers or bags out for pick-up no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the day before your pick-up day.
- * Make sure your trash is out (curbside) for pick-up by 6:00 a.m. on pick up day. Sanitation employees start work at 6:00 a.m.
- * Yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves, and twigs must be separately bagged and placed at the curb.
- * Bags should not exceed 32 gallons for grass 45 gallons for leaves.
- * Branches and brush should be bundled and tied in manageable bundles (maximum 4 feet in length and placed at the curb).
- * Carpeting must be cut down to manageable size (maximum 4 feet in length) and weight, rolled and tied and placed at the curb for pick-up.

- * Two (2) large items per week (i.e. furniture) may be placed at curb side on regular collection day at no additional charge.
- * Dumpsters are available in a variety of sizes and may be rented for special household cleanouts, remodeling and construction.

DON'T'S

- * The Sanitation Department does not collect or haul construction materials with its normal pick-up. The Sanitation Department will haul construction material separately for an additional fee. (Call 330-489-3020) **Note that asphalt, concrete, bricks and roofing material will NOT be picked up by the Sanitation Department under ANY circumstances.**
- * Tree stumps, logs, railroad ties, car parts, ashes, rocks or paint will **NOT** be picked up by the Sanitation Department.
- * Paint or liquids of any type **CANNOT** be picked up by the Sanitation Department.
- * Animal waste (feces) will **NOT** be picked up by the Sanitation Department **UNLESS** it is placed in a small sturdy double plastic bag or wrapped in newspaper and placed in a small sturdy plastic bag. Soiled cat litter can be placed in coffee cans, sturdy plastic bags, or grocery bags inside of a sturdy plastic bag. These "double bagged" packages of animal waste can then be placed in with your regular trash collection. Our Sanitation employees can collect animal waste **ONLY** if those employees can collect and dispose of the waste without coming into contact with the animal waste. **Sanitation will not collect your animal waste if it is not properly packaged, or the amount is excessive.**

Persons who violate this policy will be reported to the Canton City Health Department. Inquiry about animal waste may be made to the Canton City Health Department at 330-489-3231.

- * **All Mattresses, Box Springs and Upholstered furniture MUST be wrapped in plastic and securely sealed prior to pick up. Furniture with exposed bed bugs will NOT be picked up by the Sanitation Department.**
- * Tires will not be picked up if placed out with the regular trash. The City of Canton provides for tires to be dropped off by its citizens at the Schroyer facility located between 6th and 9th St S.W. The hours are 10:00 am - 2:00 pm, on Monday, Wednesday and Friday only. Tires only- **NO RIMS.**
- * Vacant Houses: The Sanitation Department does not maintain regular pick-up at vacant homes. After the home is vacated, a final pick-up will be made. Another pick-up prior to the occupation of the property. The Sanitation Department has discovered that regular pick-up at vacant properties exposes the department to a high incidence of outsiders fraudulently dropping off trash without the property owners' permission or other fraudulent practices. If the period between the final clean-out and pre-move-in pick-up is greater than 2 months, the property owner may apply for a waiver of their sanitation charge for that period.
